

Backup Materials - Important Notes

To confirm your status as a Australian Book of Records record breaker we must be satisfied that we can use the materials you provide in support of your record attempt in any media without further reference to you or to any third party. This not only includes our website and publication, but also television, radio, videocassettes and the internet. It is important you give careful consideration to materials you intend to submit.

Ideally, endeavour to keep your Backup materials as simple as possible, to ensure you have overall control. Follow the rules and regulations that accompany your record attempt and submit only what has been requested by The Australian Book of Records.

If you are required to include photographs, or video footage ensure that the camera operator or videographer has signed this form to give permission to use the said materials, otherwise you may find they may indeed own the rights to this data.

Consider the list below carefully and ensure it is completed thoroughly.

Please note:

The Australian Book of Records **DO NOT** return any materials sent to backup a record claim.

ORIGINAL witness statements and log books **ONLY**, will be accepted.

COPIES of other supporting data e.g. photographs, videos and so on will be accepted.
